Initiative. Many groups responded with new ways of relating to each other to carry on building a community in the face of the lethal blow of the pandemic.

Imagination, managing to make a virtue of necessity. By adapting and seizing the opportunities offered by new technology to respond ingeniously, quickly and effectively to the need for communication posed by this health crisis.

All your "discoveries" cannot replace human relations and personal, physical, palpable contact. The direct communication with nothing in the way that we Basques are so fond of. But the fact is that, amid so much misfortune, the Basque community abroad has shown itself more dynamic and caring than ever, with incredible drive and a tremendous determination to look to the future with hope.
